Mitch Niekamp - Quarterback - Illinois College Senior - Camp Point, Ill.

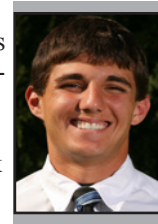
Niekamp had a banner day in the Blueboys 40-35 win over Ripon on Saturday. Niekamp went 26-of-41 for 432 yards and four touchdowns. The 432 passing yards were the most by any MWC quarterback this season and ranks as the 14th most passing yards all-time in the MWC. He was an integral part of comeback that saw the Blueboys erase a 35-21 fourth quarter deficit. Niekamp hit Brock Thompson on a 98 yard touchdown pass to cut the Red Hawks lead to one then hit Brett Eschman with just over three minutes remaining for the winning score. On the season he has completed 173 passes for 2,053 yards and 18 touchdowns.



--DEFENSIVE PERFORMER OF THE WEEK--

Ed Dobernig - Defensive Back - Lake Forest College Freshman- New Berlin, Wis.

Dobernig intercepted a pair of fourth quarter passes to help secure the Foresters' 35-14 victory over visiting Lawrence on Saturday. The first came at the Lake Forest 19-yardline with the home team nursing a 21-14 advantage. He returned his second pick of the game 39 yards for a touchdown with 1:22 to play to seal the win. He also recorded five tackles, including four solos, in the contest.



MWC News & Notes

Beloit College 34, Monmouth College 27

Beloit used two early touchdowns, and never trailed, as they earned their fourth win of the season over Monmouth, 34-27 on Saturday afternoon in Beloit, Wis. Andrew Christensen took the opening kickoff back 86 yards for a touchdown and scored on a nine yard pass from Brian Maughn to start the second quarter to give the Bucs a lead they would never relinquish. Monmouth pulled the game within seven after a Spencer Brown 35 yard reception from Brik Wedekind with 18 seconds left in the half, but Beloit answered back with two Derek Carrier touchdown catches in the third quarter to pull away. Carrier finished the day with four catches for 127 yards and two touchdowns as Julian Ross set a new Beloit career receptions record after grabbing five balls for 72 yards. Brian Maughn completed 18-of-26 passes for 252 yards and two touchdowns for the Bucs. Monmouth was led by Matt Shepherd who caught nine passes for 141 yards. Wedekind went 17-of-33 for 214 yards and no touchdowns in the loss for the Fighting Scots. Beloit's Matt Fogerty led all tacklers with 12 (eight solo) and a sack while Adam Hoste led Monmouth with 10. Both teams nearly gained 400 yards each of total offense (BC: 389, MC: 381) in a game that featured no turnovers on either side.

Carroll University 35, Knox College 0

Carroll used 460 yards of total offense and a stifling defense to shutout Knox 35-0 at the Knosher Bowl in Galesburg, Ill on Saturday afternoon. The Carroll defense intercepted three passes and yielded only 175 yards to the Prairie Fire as they are now one of four teams deadlocked at the top of the MWC standings with a 5-2 conference record. Drew Volkmann broke a scoreless game in the opening seconds of the second quarter with a one yard touchdown run to cap off an eight play, 86 yard drive to give the Pioneers all the points they would need. Joe Beckstrand put the game away in the second quarter with two touchdown runs, the second of which ended a 13 play, 99 yard drive to make the score 21-0 at the half. Chris Casper tossed two second half touchdown passes to round out the scoring for Carroll. Beckstrand led all ball carriers with 144 yards on 18 carries as Drew Volkmann also carried the ball 18 times for 117 yards and a touchdown. Casper led the passing attack for Carroll with 179 yards on 17 completions. The Prairie Fire got 51 yards on 11 carries from Luke Northam as the Knox passing attack was limited to only seven completions and 63 yards between two quarterbacks. Mike Dzewit made a team high six tackles for Carroll and picked off two passes and Lucas Motta made six tackles for Knox.

St. Norbert College 58, Grinnell College 14

St. Norbert raced out to an early lead and never looked back, pulling into a first place tie with three other teams after a 58-14 win over Grinnell on Saturday. St. Norbert rolled early and scored the games first 37 points en route to a 37-7 halftime lead. Rob Berger hooked up with Joe Green twice in the first half, hitting him from 25 and 20 yards out and Berger also ran in for a score to set the tone. The Pioneers finally cracked the scoreboard in the waning seconds of the first half when Robert Seer caught a 17 yard touchdown pass from Mike McCabe. The Green Knights responded out of the half with the next three scores, all touchdowns, to open up its biggest lead (58-7) before McCabe found Cody Weber with 30 seconds left on the board to round out the scoring. All told St. Norbert racked up 488 yards of total offense and had five takeaways on defense. Berger completed 15-of-26 passes for 170 yards and four touchdowns while also running for 116 yards and a score on eight carries. Joe Green caught seven passes for 96 yards and two touchdowns and Logan Krueger also caught two touchdown passes and had 98 yards and three receptions. For the Pioneers McCabe completed 18 passes for 244 yards with Seer his favorite target catching nine passes for 116 yards and a touchdown. McCabe was also Monmouth's top rusher with 70 yards on 12 carries.

Lake Forest College 35, Lawrence University 14

A pair of fourth quarter touchdowns broke open a close game and gave Lake Forest their first win of the season, 35-14 over Lawrence at Farwell Field in Lake Forest, Ill. The Foresters took a commanding 21-0 lead at the half with a pair of touchdown runs by Ty Van Valkenburg and a five yard run by Al Mitchell to set the tone. Out of the half the Vikings answered back and scored 14 third quarter points to pull the Foresters lead to only seven going into the final quarter. Sam Kossow found Jon Bruehl from three yards out to get the Vikings on the board. Kossow struck again 10 minutes later when he found Jeremiah Johnson in the back of the end zone to make it a seven point game. Lake Forest regained the two score lead with only 6:42 left in the game on a 59 yard touchdown pass from Pete Scaffidi to Kevin Davis. The Foresters iced the game in the final minutes when Ed Dobernick intercepted Kossow and took it back 39 yards for a touchdown. Scaffidi completed 14-of-21 passes for 155 yards and a touchdown while the Foresters racked up 187 yards on the ground, led by Brock Stenberg with 75 yards on 19 carries. Kossow led the Vikings both in the air and on the ground, throwing for 279 yards on 26 completions and ran for 45 yards.

Illinois College 40, Ripon College 35

Illinois College used 19 fourth quarter points and a career day from quarterback Mitch Niekamp to down Ripon 40-35 at England Stadium in Jacksonville, Ill. Ripon opened up the game scoring the first 13 points on a Ben Garland touchdown catch and a Tom Sawyer nine yard touchdown run to cap off two long scoring drives for the Red Hawks. The Blueboys answered right back with two straight touchdowns to take a 14-13 lead. Ripon took the final lead of the half as David Ross hulled in a 30 yard touchdown pass from Sawyer for a 21-14 halftime lead. Ripon extended its advantage to 14 after a Jake Marshall 52 yard run early in the fourth quarter. Keith Hunter got Illinois C. back into the game on the ensuing kickoff by taking it 96 yards for a touchdown, cutting the Red Hawks lead to seven. After forcing Ripon to punt, Niekamp found Brock Thompson on the second play of the drive for a 98 yard touchdown pass and after a failed extra point still trailed Ripon, 35-34. With the Red Hawks deep in Illinois C. territory Eric Fisher intercepted a pass to set up the game winning drive. The Blueboys then went 85 yards on only three plays capped off by a Niekamp touchdown pass to Brett Eschman for the eventual winning points. Niekamp finished the game with 432 yards passing on 26 completions with four touchdown tosses. Thompson was his favorite receiver catching four passes for 168 yards. The Red Hawks churned out 391 yards on the ground led by Max Hermann with 102 yards on only eight carries while Marshall (11 car. 98 yards, 2 TD), Sawyer (11 car. 65 yards, 1 TD) and T.J. Pierce (12 car. 56 yards) all gained more than 50 yards on the ground. With the result of the game it puts both teams in a four way tie for first place in the MWC.
