--OFFENSIVE PERFORMER OF THE WEEK--

**Pete Scaffidi - Quarterback - Lake Forest College
Junior - South Elgin, Ill.**

Scaffidi completed 17 of 29 passes for 367 yards and five touchdowns in Lake Forest's 56-38 victory at Lawrence on Saturday. He also reached the end zone on a 1-yard run. Scaffidi's five passing touchdowns tie the team record he set five weeks ago and give him a 25 on the season, surpassing the previous school record of 20.



--SPECIAL TEAMS PERFORMER OF THE WEEK--

**Jacob Gahart - Kicker - Ripon College
Junior - Elkhorn, Wis.**

Gahart connected on both of his field goal attempts, converting from 19 and 43 yards, while also making all three of his extra points in Saturday's 34-33 loss to Illinois College. That gives Gahart a conference-best 10 field goals for the season, which breaks Ripon's single season record. Gahart also broke the school's career field goal mark with the 26th of his career.

**Austin Arts - Defensive Back - St. Norbert College
Junior - Kimberly, Wis.**

Arts helped St. Norbert hold off Grinnell in a 30-28 road win for the Green Knights. On the game's third play from scrimmage, Arts intercepted a Grinnell pass for a 43-yard touchdown return - the Green Knights' first defensive touchdown this season. Then, with Grinnell driving for a potential game-winning score, Arts made the game-saving interception at the St. Norbert 24-yard line with 34 seconds left.



MWC Game Recaps

Monmouth College 63, Beloit College 41

Monmouth racked up 560 yards of total offense and moved one game closer to clinching the MWC championship with a 63-41 shoot-out win over Beloit at Monmouth, Ill. on Saturday afternoon. Beloit opened the game with a Dillon Hess 10 yard touchdown run for a 7-0 lead but it was the only lead they would hold the rest of the day. The Bucs were as close as eight (42-34) late in the third quarter but Monmouth put no doubt in the result as they would outscore Beloit 21-7 the rest of the way. Alex Tanney was again sharp going 19-of-24 for 305 yards and five touchdowns while Trey Yocum gained 180 yards on 27 carries and three scores. Mike Blodgett was the top target for the Fighting Scots with nine catches for 111 yards and two touchdowns. Terence Steward scored two touchdowns and gained 149 on the ground for Beloit and Derek Carrier caught seven passes for 129 yards and a score to lead Beloit. Rod Ojong had a game-high 13 tackles for Monmouth while Ryan Flannigan picked off two passes and had six tackles for Monmouth. Zach Bock had nine tackles and Derrell Carter had the only two tackles for loss for Beloit in the loss.

Lake Forest College 56, Lawrence University 38

Lake Forest and Lawrence scored at least a touchdown in every quarter of play and racked up 922 yards of combined offense in a 56-38 win for Lake Forest. The win was the second in the last three weeks for the Foresters. Lake Forest had one of its best offensive days of the season with 27 first downs and 610 yards of total yards while holding a decisive advantage in time of possession (38:56 – 21:04). Forester quarterback Pete Scaffidi threw for 367 yards and five touchdowns on only 17 completions, finding Kevin Davis five times for 152 yards and three touchdowns. Al Mitchell carried the ground game that gained 239 total yards with 27 carries for 127 yards and a touchdown. Tyler Mazur accounted for four touchdowns for the Vikings as he caught seven passes for 63 yards and two touchdowns and ran for 31 yards on five carries and two touchdowns. Luke Barthelme went 19-of-26 for 215 yards and three touchdowns for Lawrence in defeat. Luke Butts led Lake Forest with 12 tackles (10 solo) and two tackles for loss in the win while Mats Jonsson had 12 tackles (seven solo) and a forced fumble for the Vikings.

Illinois College 34, Ripon College 33

Illinois C. scored a touchdown with 1:40 left and took a win away from Ripon to keep themselves in contention for the MWC championship with a 33-32 win at Ingalls Field in Ripon, Wis. After the Red Hawks opened the game with a T.J. Pierce 24 yard touchdown run the Blueboys reeled off the next 21 points to take a 21-7 lead. Ripon then outscored Illinois C. 19-7 to start the second half which set up the dramatic finish. The Blueboys went on a six play, 66 yard, drive that only took 57 seconds and ended with a Kevin Wallace 18 yard touchdown pass from Michael Bates to give the visitor the one point win. Bates led the offense going 16-of-28 for 208 yards and two touchdowns while also carrying the ball 17 times for 108 yards and a touchdown. Ripon continued to display its strong running game with 375 yards on 72 carries, led by Pierce who gained 141 yards on 22 carries and scored twice. Jacob Gahart also knocked down two field goals (19, 43) which increased his season field goal total to 10, a new Ripon record. Eric Fisher led all defensive players with 14 tackles for Illinois C.

St. Norbert College 30, Grinnell College 28

The St. Norbert defense started off the day with an Austin Arts 43 yard interception return for a touchdown and then ended a Grinnell chance at victory with an interception by Arts with 34 seconds left to come away with a 30-28 win at Rosenbloom Field in Grinnell, Iowa. Grinnell pulled to within two after a Robert Seer five yard touchdown catch from Mike McCabe with 6:04 remaining and then got the ball back with 2:18 left for a chance at victory. The Pioneers used 11 plays to get to the St. Norbert 44 yard line before Arts ended the game with his second interception of the game. Kevin Hansen led the Green Knights offense going 22-of-34 for 329 yards and a touchdown pass, finding Joe Green 10 times for 138 yards. The St. Norbert rushing offense was led by Craig Fagan who carried the ball 17 times for 131 and a score. The Green Knights defense was also stout against the run as Grinnell finished the game with negative rushing yards on only 12 carries. Quarterback Mike McCabe made up for the lack of a running attack with 470 yards passing and four touchdowns through the air. McCabe's favorite target was Seer who caught 14 passes for 204 yards and three touchdowns.

Carroll University 30, Knox College 8

Knox opened up the scoring with a nine play, 75 yard drive that culminated in a Derek Mortensen two yard touchdown run to give the Prairie Fire a 6-0 lead but would not register two points the rest of the game in a 30-8 loss to Carroll. The Pioneers scored its first points on a blocked extra point attempt on the Knox touchdown and returned it for two points and then got three rushing touchdowns from Joe Beckstrand to roll past Knox. Beckstrand finished the day with 138 yards on 25 carries while quarterback Ryan Young threw for 233 yards and a score. Nate Soddy led all receivers with six catches and 135 yards in the win for Carroll. Knox was carried by Mortensen who had 83 yards on the ground, including the score, while receiver Dustin Armstrong made four catches for 111 yards. Mike Hendrick led all defensive players with 10 tackles and two sacks for Knox. Hendrick also had four tackles for loss on a Prairie Fire defense that picked up five sacks on the day, including a safety by Steve Bora. Mike Dziewit led Carroll with eight tackles (six solo) in the victory.
