### --PERFORMER OF THE WEEK--

#### Taylor Koth - Forward - Ripon College Junior - Cedarburg, Wis.

Koth helped Ripon win two of their three games last week, moving the Red Hawks into a tie for third place in the MWC standings. His week was highlighted by a 48-point, 17-rebound performance in a win over Grinnell on Friday, which tied a school record for most points in a single game. For the week, Koth averaged 31.3 points, 11.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.0 steals per game, while posting his 18th and 19th double doubles of his career. He also shot 52 percent (30-58) from the field, 33 percent (1-3) from 3-point range and 85 percent (33-39) from the free throw line.

- Lentsch also cracked the MWC record book in that game with fg made (27, first), fg attempted (55, second), 3fg attempted (33, third), 3fg made (15, third) and free throws made (20, second)
- Lake Forest set a school record with 15 straight wins from Nov. 17 through Jan. 25
- Aris Wurtz became the fourth Ripon player to score 1,600 points and is within striking distance of the school record for scoring (1,871)
- Ripon head coach Bob Gillespie captured his 500th win on Dec 2.
- Knox's Ben Wetherbee set the Knox record for most three-point field goals made in a Jan.31 loss to Carroll.
- Ripon's Taylor Koth tied a school record with 48 points in a Feb. 3 win over Grinnell
